

Kids' Pool Rules & Regulations

Please follow these pool rules to help ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.

Water Slide Rules

Minimum height to ride: 110 cm

Maximum height to ride: 140 cm

Open Slides (Red & Blue): You can slide sitting or lying on your back.

Closed Slide (Green): You must lie on your back.

Children under 110 cm (42 inches) can use the green slide only if they are accompanied by an adult. The adult must hug and/or securely hold the child (in the adult's arms), before they slide down the green slide.

General Pool Rules

- Pool hours: 09:00 – 19:00
- Lifeguard on duty: 09:00 – 19:00
- Children under 3 years old must wear swim diapers with rubber pants.
- Children under 16 years old must always be watched by an adult.
- No floats or toys allowed on the water slides.
- Follow the lifeguard's and staff's instructions at all times.
- Stay in the correct position during all rides.
- Always keep hands inside the slide.
- No stopping, turning, standing, kneeling, or rotating.
- Wear swimwear without buckles or sharp objects on the slides.
- Please shower before entering the pool.
- No diving, running, or rough play is allowed.

- No glass items are allowed in the pool area.
- Do not enter the pool if you are sick or have a skin condition.
- Do not swim if you have consumed alcohol. Guests under the influence of alcohol will not be allowed to enter the pools.
- No smoking in the pool area.
- No pets allowed in the pool area.
- Use the pool at your own risk.
- Maximum number of people in the pool: 150.

IMPORTANT: Failure to comply with these rules and regulations and/or the instructions of the lifeguards and/or the Hotel's employees, may result in your immediate removal or expulsion from a specific pool or the Hotel's pool areas in general. You may be temporarily or permanently banned from the pool area(s) of the Hotel. Such decision is at the sole discretion of the Hotel and the Hotel's decision is final.

The Hotel may change these rules at any time. Staff has the final say on all rules.

Look for the signs with symbols to help understand the rules easily. A height ruler is placed near the slide entrance to check rider's height.
