## **Rules & Safety Guidelines**

Your safety and enjoyment are our top priorities. Kindly take a moment to review the following guidelines before using the Waverider.

## **Operating Hours:**

April to October (Summer): 12:00 - 15:00

November to March (Winter): Closed

## **Important Information:**

All guests must attend a brief safety induction and sign a waiver prior to using the facility.

Participation in this activity is entirely at your own risk.

## **Eligibility & Safety Requirements:**

- Minimum height requirement: 1.2 meters (4 ft).
- Guests must be in good physical condition and medically fit to participate.
- The Waverider is not suitable for individuals with heart conditions, back or neck problems, or other medical concerns that may be aggravated by the activity.
- Use of the Waverider is strictly prohibited under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Pregnant guests are kindly advised not to participate, for safety reasons.
- Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian and have written consent.
- Non-swimmers are not permitted to use the attraction.

## **Guest Conduct & Usage Guidelines:**

- Please follow all staff instructions at all times.
- Wait for your turn and exit the ride area promptly after your session to allow access for others.
- Only one person is allowed on the Waverider at a time.
- No stunts or acrobatics are permitted for safety reasons.



- All sharp objects, watches, and jewellery must be removed prior to entering the ride.
- Guests are encouraged to take extreme care when entering and exiting the attraction.
- Always observe signage and safety markers for your protection.
- Kindly pay close attention to the safety briefing prior to use.
